



Snowmobile Program COVID-19 Operational Plan

Overall Safety Measures:

- Measures implemented to help minimize exposure of COVID-19 to employees, guests, and the community.
- Guides will receive training on COVID-19 symptoms, isolation protocol, PPE, state and local protocols.
- Face coverings are to be worn at all appropriate times while checking guests in and out, while instructing and assisting guests with sleds.
- While on the mountain guests and employees exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 will be asked to leave the mountain or referred to ski patrol if unable to leave.
- Guests must follow all Brundage, county and state policies.
- Guests not in compliance with Brundage policies will be asked to comply or leave.

Cleaning and Sanitization

- High contact surfaces such as doorknobs, locker doors and security alarms will be disinfected at the beginning of each day.
- The locker room benches will be disinfected at the end of each day.
- All guest apparel will be sprayed down on the collars, sleeves and inside on the back, armpit and chest area, every time used. Every two weeks an additional product will be used to create a protective barrier for the garments.

Employee Health

- Temp check and health questionnaires will be taken at the locker room each morning.
- Employees who feel sick will be asked to stay home and not return until advised by management.
- Appropriate quarantine protocols will be followed for sick employees.
- Passes of employees who are on quarantine will not be valid during quarantine.
- Employees will sanitize their hands throughout the day.
- Employees will have face coverings available from Human Resources.

Guest Health

- All snowmobiles and gear will be disinfected after each use.
- We will maintain a minimum of 6' of physical distancing wherever possible.
- Clients will be seen at their scheduled appointment time.
- Common Areas are MASK-UP Zones (Face coverings worn properly over the nose and mouth. Need to stay up on their own without the use of hands.)
- Guests who are ill are requested to refrain from visiting Brundage and delay travel until at least 10 days after symptoms first appeared, AND other symptoms have improved AND no fever for at least 24 hours, without fever-reducing medicine
- Guests who become ill during their visit should notify patrol at onset of symptoms and should self-isolate immediately if unable to self-isolate guest will be taken to an isolation area by patrol.
- Guests who become ill or confirmed with COVID-19 within 14 days of their visit should notify Brundage management.

Physical Distancing Measures

- Guests within the same tour group/rental group will be allowed to dress at the same time. Separate riding groups will have to wait outside the locker room until cleared and wiped down.
- Locker room door should be opened for at least 1 min. between groups.
- Guides will lead by example with the 6ft. rule while instructing.
- Pay attention in allowing people the space they seem most comfortable with, if they need more, give it to them.

Communication

- We CANNOT over communicate on this. Whether winning or losing communication is key.
- Express any and all concerns for everyone's health and safety.
