






Addendum A to BMR Operating Plan Winter Devices Allowed & Not Allowed on Lifts or Trails

For the safety of Brundage employees and guests while loading and riding lifts and while sliding down the mountain, please refer to the table for allowed equipment. Should you wish to have Brundage Mountain Resort review a device that is not addressed to be allowed as a reasonable accommodation for access, please e-mail Risk Management/Patrol at patrol@brundage.com.



ALLOWED ON LIFTS AND TRAILS		
SKIS 	ALLOWED	Skis must have metal edges. Brakes or retention device required.
TELEMARK SKIS 	ALLOWED	Skis must have metal edges. Brakes or Retention device required.
SKIMO SKIS 	ALLOWED	Skis must have metal edges. Brakes or retention device required.
SNOWBOARD 	ALLOWED	Must have metal edges. Bindings must secure boots to board. Lift ridden with 1 foot buckled into binding. A retention device is required.
MONOSKI 	ALLOWED	Must have metal edges. Brakes or retention device required.
SNOWBLADES 	ALLOWED	Must have metal edges. Brakes or retention device required.

<p>SKI BIKES & SNOWBIKES</p> 	<p>ALLOWED</p>	<p>Must be designed to load and unload lift without slowing or stopping. Rider must be able to ride onto lift and ride off the lift. Device should be designed and loaded so safety bar can be lowered. Only 1 rider per bike. Bikes should be able to fall over if separated from rider. A leash designed to prevent runaway devices must be worn at all times and be attached between the device and rider. Commercially available bikes only. No homemade conversions.</p>
<p>SNOWTRIKE/SNO-GO</p> 	<p>ALLOWED</p>	<p>Must be designed to load and unload lift without slowing or stopping. Rider must be able to ride onto lift and ride off the lift. Device should be designed and loaded so safety bar can be lowered. Only 1 rider per bike. A leash designed to stop the device and prevent runaway devices must be worn at all times and be attached between the device and rider. Commercially available bikes only. No homemade conversions.</p>
<p>SNOWSCOOT</p> 	<p>ALLOWED</p>	<p>Must be designed to load and unload lift without slowing or stopping. Rider must be able to ride onto lift and ride off the lift. Device should be designed and loaded so safety bar can be lowered. Only 1 rider per bike. A leash designed to stop the device and prevent runaway devices must be worn at all times and be attached between the device and rider. Commercially available Snowscoots only. No homemade conversions.</p>
<p>SNOWSKATE (BI-LEVEL)</p> 	<p>ALLOWED</p>	<p>Skateboard deck with trucks mounted on sliding ski. Must have metal edges. A leash designed to stop the device and prevent runaway devices must be worn at all times and be attached between the device and rider. Deck must be ridden off the lift. When riding, user must stand on deck.</p>

<p>SKI SKATES (ODR, SLED DOGS, SKI SKATES)</p> 	<p>ALLOWED</p>	<p>Must have metal edges. Protective cover must be worn indoors.</p>
<p>ADAPTIVE EQUIPMENT DESIGNED FOR ADAPTIVE RIDERS MEETING ANSI STANDARDS FOR USE WITHIN THE SKI INDUSTRY</p>	<p>ALLOWED</p>	<p>Devices specifically designed to be utilized by adaptive riders that meets ANSI standards and are specifically recognized as adaptive device. Must have a center point balance system/attachment integrated for lift evacuation.</p>

EQUIPMENT NOT ALLOWED ON LIFTS AND TRAILS

<p>TANDEM DEVICES</p> 	<p>NOT ALLOWED</p>	<p>1 Person per device.</p>
<p>SNOWSHOES</p> 	<p>NOT ALLOWED</p>	<p>Not allowed on lifts or trails during operating hours. May be used for uphill access as outlined in the "Brundage Uphill Travel Policy"</p>

<p>FATBIKES & OTHER WHEELED DEVICES</p> 	<p>NOT ALLOWED (WINTER)</p>	
<p>SNOW BIKE (CONVERSION KIT)</p> 	<p>NOT ALLOWED</p>	<p>Snow bikes are not allowed to have gears, chain, wheels, tires or a crank assembly</p>
<p>PLASTIC SKIS, SNOWBOARDS, & OTHER DEVICES</p> 	<p>NOT ALLOWED</p>	<p>Skis, snowboards, and all other allowed devices must have metal edges. Cross country skis without metal edges are not allowed and not recommended for downhill skiing for those accessing the mountain via our “uphill access policy”</p>
<p>SNOW FEET</p> 	<p>NOT ALLOWED</p>	<p>Plastic style attachment for shoes and boots. Not allowed even with metal edges. Designed for hiking trails and sledding hills.</p>
<p>POWDER SURFER</p> 	<p>NOT ALLOWED</p>	<p>Snowboard without bindings designed for backyard and backcountry use.</p>
<p>SINGLE DECK</p> 	<p>NOT ALLOWED</p>	<p>Single deck, typically plastic toy, or PTEX base. Not allowed even with metal edges.</p>

<p>DUAL BOARD SNOWBOARDS</p> 	<p>NOT ALLOWED</p>	
<p>SLEDS/DISCS/TOBOGGANS/AIR BOARDS/TUBES/BODY SLEDS/GHOSKY/ETC.</p> 	<p>NOT ALLOWED</p>	<p>Sledding at Brundage is not allowed at any time within the ski area permit area, parking areas, or private property.</p>
<p>BABY BACKPACKS/CARRIERS/WRAPS/SLINGS</p> 	<p>NOT ALLOWED</p>	
<p>SNOWMOBILES/MOTORIZED SNOWBIKES/TRACKED VEHICLES</p> 	<p>NOT ALLOWED</p>	<p>Only snowmobiles owned and operated by the Resort, or contractors of the Resort, with pre-approval, are allowed.</p>
<p>UNAUTHORIZED DRONES</p> 	<p>NOT ALLOWED</p>	<p>Only drones owned and operated by the Resort, or contractors of the Resort with pre-approval, are allowed.</p>
<p>PARAGLIDING/HANGLIDING/KITES</p> 	<p>NOT ALLOWED</p>
